Variety

Tempranillo Touriga

Vineyard

Heathcote Ridge and Rathjen vineyards located in northern Heathcote.

Season

Late cool growing season with timely rainfall. Ideal for the mediterranean varieties like Tempranillo and Touriga Nacional.

Tasting Note

Brilliant crimson purple colour. Deeply scented dark fruits, good fruit concentration, spice and violets. Supple and integrated tannins, textural, plummy and very delicious.

Winemaking

Each variety is vinified in both open top and closed fermenters. Warm fermentation over 14 days. 4 months in 500 litre French oak puncheons (5% new).

Alc/Vol: 14.0%, pH: 3.55, TA: 6.38g/L.

This wine will continue to develop beautifully over the next 4-6 years if stored in a cool dark place.
