DEEN VAT 5 BOTRYTIS SEMILLON 2022

Vineyard

The fruit for this wine is sourced from vineyards off the estate as well as those with a long history of growing exceptional quality Botrytis fruit for De Bortoli Wines.

Season

Early summer rains once again impacted the Botrytis harvest with rain in early January and again in early March kicking off the botrytis throughout the vineyard leading to one of the earliest harvests on record beginning on March 24.

Tasting Note

Pale gold in colour. A nose with subtle spices such as nutmeg and cedar wood, which explodes into pineapple and orange rind notes. The palate is long and fine. With barley sugar & dried apricot flavours leading the charge. Finishing delightfully delicious.

Suggested Cuisine

A sweet white wine that perfectly pairs with your favourite citrus dessert such as Lemon and Coconut Delicious or a Lemon and Lime Cheesecake. Or be daring and try with Roast Quail, apple and quince puree, with a sticky balsamic glaze.
