Freemans Bridge Block 9 & 10 Shiraz were planted in 2004. This site has very unique profile with a shallow horizon of deep red Cambrian soil over a substantial layer of near pure limestone. The vines are naturally low cropping and have very soil driven characteristics. No other block that we cultivate or purchase from has this distinctiveness.

Tasting Note
Dark colour with brightness. Dense, deeply scented sweet fruits, violets and earth. Ripe blueberry, fine tannin, lots of flesh, silken feel.
