## RIORRET BALNARRING PINOT NOIR 2015

### Vineyard

Owned by Campbell and Christine Penfold. Proper 'village' wine. Grown on the boundary of the Balnarring Village on Warrawee Rd. East facing slope, low yields, concentrated fruit, terrific site.

### Season

A mild season with a lovely aromatics, plumpness, charm and fine tannins. Quite fine and composed, good natural acidity. Perhaps a bit more charm and perfume than past few vintages.

### Tasting Note

Bright, slightly crunchy Pinot, darker fruits, highly aromatic, nuance of stems, gentle flavours, plump, spice, supple, charming.

### Suggested Cuisine

Pappardelle with duck ragù

Vegan, Vegetarian

### Winemaking

Hand picked and sorted, 20% whole bunches, 18 days on skins. Matured on fine lees in new and used casks for 9 months. Gravity at all stages.

### Wine Analysis

Alc/Vol 13.5% pH 3.49 TA 5.9g/L

### Cellaring

Store in a cool cellar and this wine will develop further complexity with four to five years.
